

Dear Lake Friends:

Several have asked about the volume of the SisBio diffusers... Here is their response:

Each RADOR diffuser operates at 5 CFM—cubic feet per minute. That translates into 2244 gallons per hour. Take that times 24 hours x 50 diffusers = 2,692,800 gallons per day!

Today is the last day to sign up for our Thursday, March 4 zoom meetings! We will host one at 3 pm and another at 7 pm. We already have 18 more signed up—which will bring our total participants to over 200!!!

THANK YOU to the 42 families who have made early gifts/pledges of \$200,850 so far (as of March 2, 2021).
